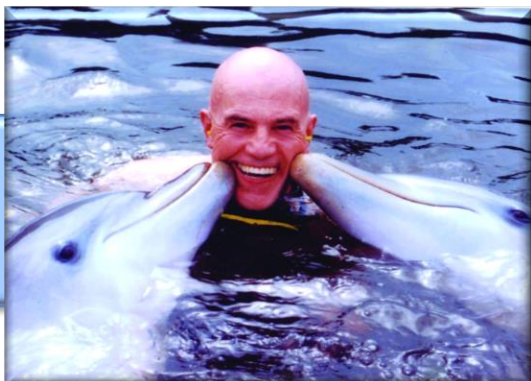




CURRICULUM VITAE

Dr. Paul Greenacre DDS



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SUMMARY

Dr. Paul Greenacre was born in South Porcupine, near Timmins in Northern Ontario, Canada. As a teenager he had a market garden where he grew and sold vegetables. He also worked in an apiary. He was also fascinated with bush pilots and floatplanes. As a result of that interest, he obtained his private pilot license at age 16; even before he got his driver's license.

At 16 years of age he was also accepted into the pre-med program at McGill University in Montreal. At 18 he was accepted into both The University of Toronto and McGill University's Dental Programs. He decided to go into McGill's Dentistry program and in 1970 at the age of 23, he graduated from that program. Paul was the only Canadian Dental Student at the 1970 International Dental Students Association Conference in Malmo, Sweden and Copenhagen, Denmark.

Today, at 73, he has surpassed 50 years of continuous practice. To date, Dr. Greenacre has obtained 5 Fellowships in dentistry and has published many articles such as, "*Why the Human Face is Shrinking*", and "*Maxillary Dysmorphogenesis*" and has also spent 10 years as a dental editor. In addition, he has also presented to multiple groups and organizations on topics related to: *Medical Dentistry*, *How Oral Health affects Overall Health* and *Airway Alignment and Orthodontics*, to name a few.

Dr. Greenacre continues to practice dentistry 5 days a week and enjoys the company of four adult children and one "Miss Maya", his treasured granddaughter.

5 Professional Themes of Practices

1st Theme - How Oral Health Affects Total Health – Medical Dentistry – “Meet the MDs”

During his years at McGill, Dr. Greenacre was intrigued and inspired by the writings of Sir William Osler, one of McGill's most famous professors. He was particularly fascinated with Osler's remark that "The Mouth is the mirror of all disease.", and further Dr. Osler's comment "The eye cannot see what the mind does not already know." This started his dedication to exploring how oral health affects total health. Thanks to the Sir William Osler Library at McGill, *How Oral Health Affects Total Health* has become the first of 5 philosophical and professional themes of his practice and studies.

2nd Theme - Decathlon Dentistry

Dr. Greenacre was also greatly influenced by the teachings of McGill Professor Dr. Ernest Ambrose who invited guest lecturer, Dr. Robert Barkley, of Macomb, Illinois in 1968 to speak to the McGill dental students. Dr. Barkley became a pivotal professional mentor and urged the young Dr. Greenacre to pursue a challenging mission to become a decathlon dentist and develop multiple skills in orthodontics, periodontics as well as restorative dentistry. *Decathlon Dentistry* became Dr. Greenacre's second theme of his practice.

3rd Theme - Nutrition and Total Health

Dr. Greenacre has an extraordinarily strong belief in Super-Nutrition, and he has read extensively on the connections between our biochemical-hormonal-nutritional status and our overall health. *Nutrition and Total Health* became Dr. Greenacre's third theme in his Oral Health-Total Health concept of Integrated Medicine that he presents to his clients and colleagues through nutritional counselling and microbiome understanding. Dr. Greenacre recommends viewing Dr. Lustig's YouTube presentation called "Sugar – the Bitter Truth"¹ based on the 1972 book by Dr. John Yudkin, "Pure, White and Deadly".

4th Theme – Airway and Alignment Orthodontics

Today, orthodontics is changing to keep in step with the rapid developments in sleep (or airway) medicine and integrated medicine which had correctly concluded that underdevelopment in the facial region can lead to diminished health and airway function. For instance, we have all seen children and adults who breathe either partially or wholly through their mouths with their lips apart. This and snoring are symptoms of airway dysfunction and sleep disordered breathing. Our first diagnosis duty in looking at a patient, whether they be an adult or child,

is to access the airway and determine if we can help improve it or normalize it to some extent. If the first rule of medicine is "Do no harm", then it follows that the second rule must be "Do some good!"

The specialty of Sleep Medicine has changed our approach to dentistry and orthodontics by making us realize that a well-developed upper and lower arch will help prevent mouth-breathing, snoring and sleep apnea by creating better head and neck posture and whole-body function. By examining and altering bite alignment and by addressing the patient's airway with a series of orthodontic appliances and techniques, we can significantly improve the patient's overall health. This became Dr. Greenacre's 4th professional theme of practice.

5th Theme - Ten Step Protocol for Recovering Periodontal Health

In developing the Ten Step Protocol for Recovering Periodontal Health, Dr. Greenacre has established a unique process to thoroughly diagnose and effectively treat periodontal disease. Noting "We must be aware of the considerable data and the growing body of evidence that implies that periodontal diseases are whole body infections that are possibly and very probably related to many different medical conditions", and, in his professional opinion, the failure to diagnose and properly treat gum disease is overlooking a substantial source of whole-body inflammation.

HIGHLIGHTS OF PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE

After graduating, Dr. Greenacre practiced in Ottawa until 1972 and during this time he spearheaded the development of a 10-minute instructional film on preventive dentistry for the Canadian Armed Forces. He then became the dentist for The Royal Military College in Kingston, Ontario until 1973. For the next two years he was stationed in Baden Baden and Lahr, West Germany supporting the Royal 22nd Regiment "*The VanDoos*" of Quebec. This European experience gave him an understanding and appreciation for the European approach to dentistry and orthodontics. He readily appreciated Dr. John Witzig's and Dr. William Clark's endorsement of European Whole Person Orthodontics.

Back in Ottawa, during the late 1970s, he succeeded Dr. George Beagrie as editor of the Canadian Dental Association's Audio Cassette Continuing Education Program. For 4 years Dr. Greenacre produced a monthly hour-long audio program. In the early 1980s, Dr. Greenacre became editor of "*Dentafacts*" a sister program of "*Medifacts*", the monthly newsletter published by the Canadian College of Physicians and Surgeons. He spent the next 3 years developing dental educational packages.

In over 10 years of being a dental editor, his experiences gave him the opportunity to interview and write about hundreds of leading clinicians and specialists and their concepts and to relate their philosophies and procedures to Dentists across Canada. He has published articles in the McGill Dental Review, the Canadian Dental Association and Oral Health Magazine and he wrote an article on Sports Dentistry for the Canadian Coaching Association in 1982. These experiences prepared Dr. Greenacre to create his own practices and since the late 1980s he has developed over seven successful clinics in Canada's National Capital Region.

His medical heroes who write and practice with this theme of integrated medicine are: Dr. Norman Shealy, Dr. Leo Galland, Dr. Andrew Weil, Dr. D.S. Khalsa, Dr. Sidney Baker, Dr. Christine Northrup, Dr. Scott Peck, Dr. Larry Dossey, Dr. Stephanie Beling, Dr. James Balch, Dr. Richard Gerber, Dr. Bernie Siegal, Dr. Allan Somersaul, Dr. Robert Fulford and PhD's like Dan Colgan, Dan Baker, Gary Flint and Gary Craig.

Throughout his dental studies and practice, Dr. Greenacre has committed himself to study with over 30 orthodontists and over 100 of the finest dental instructors in the world, including: early studies in orthodontics with Dr. Lawrence Funt. This included Lectures with Dr. Janet Travell and other medical specialists in his Craniofacial Pain Institute, Dr. Nathan Shore, Dr. Errol Lader and Dr. Jack Sheridan; Studies in TMJ with Dr. Harold Gelb, Dr. John Witzig and Dr. Merle Bean; He graduated from his studies at the International Dental Institute in Montreal with Dr. Jean-Noel Lavallee and Dr. Michel Champagne with high distinction ; Then pursued studies in Whole Body Dentistry with Dr. Gerald Smith and developed his understanding of osteopathy with Dr. Steven Smith of Philadelphia; studying with Dr. Shahin Pourgol of National Academy of Osteopathy he received his license as Manual Osteopath. Other doctors he studied with are Dr. Ron Levendoski, Dr. Al Fonder, Dr. Bruce Kinnie , Dr. Jack Hayden, Dr. John Mew,

and extensively with Dr. James Garry, Dr. Brendan Stack and Dr. Brock Rondeau. A few years ago, he enjoyed the privilege of being Dr. Rondeau's teaching assistant for his Ottawa area orthodontic program.

In the last few years Dr. Greenacre has studied with Dr. Darrick Nordstrom, Dr. Derick Mahoney, Dr. John Beck, Dr. Jim Beck and more recently with Dr. William Hang. He recently completed extensive training in a San Diego residency program conducted by Dr. Steve Olmos, diplomat of the American Academy of Cranial Facial Pain.

Following this, Dr. Greenacre completed the AACP's 2008 -2009 four-session mini residency program in craniofacial pain with all the teaching faculty of the American Academy of Craniofacial Pain in Dallas-Fort Worth. This gave him his AACP fellowship.

Further Paul has completed all the basic DOCS courses for conscious sedation and has done several implant related programs and in August of 2009 received a fellowship in the International Congress of Oral Implantologists (ICOI) after completing the Carl Misch implant program. He also recently completed a cadaver course on implantology and periodontal surgery with Dr. Hom-Lay Wang in Toronto at the Mount Sinai Hospital.

Medical Dentistry

Medical Dentistry is the concept that treating, reducing, and preventing Inflammation in the body with super nutrition, along with ensuring an unobstructed Airway in conjunction with proper Alignment is the key to Total Health and Wellness. He most recently presented his lecture on Medical Dentistry to Dr. Simon Yu's annual conference in St. Louis, Missouri in 2020. Finally, his latest course was at the International Dental Institute studying bone and gum grafting, with Dr. Duc Vo in Montreal. He has also been using periodontal laser (LANAP and Waterlase techniques) to stop and reverse gum disease.

He is now planning a teaching program for physicians, dentists and allied health professionals based on the concepts of Medical Dentistry. This program will include topics such as:

- The "T.O.P.M.I.N.D". Strategy = **"Teeth, Orthodontics and Periodontics Minimally Invasive Nutritional Dentistry"**
We want to save teeth, gum tissue and jaw joints by Ph management and microbial biofilm management to minimize local and systemic inflammation and do it safely, naturally and by conservatively using: "light" therapies or laser therapies, nutraceutical systems, tooth surface cleaning and hardening, gum micro biofilm pockets management, tissue rehydration and tissue regeneration techniques
- Oral appliances to stop snoring
- The New Orthodontics for growing a healthy head, neck airway and face
- Reduce the risk of Inflammation caused by bloodstream biofilms from gum diseases and tooth diseases.
- Mandibular Rebalancing using Dr. May and Dr. Leed's protocols
- Super nutrition for modern families encouraging the Paleo Modern Concept to Build Better Babies
